Language focus: Animals, verbs connected with different places
Time (approx.): 10-12 minutes
Preparation: Photocopy one worksheet for each student

- Using the worksheet:**
- The worksheet can be done for homework or in class.
 - It is best used after you have finished chapter 15 of the Student's Book.
 - In Exercise 1, students connect activities to their places by drawing a line to connect the two items.
 - In Exercise 2, students have to write the vocabulary under the appropriate heading. Student may not know all the words in the box but ask them to guess. After checking their answers, you may need to teach some of the vocabulary items.
 - In Exercise 3, the students have to use the verbs in the box to complete the sentences. The 3 activities together work on the places, activities that take place in these places and teach some associated vocabulary.

- Additional ideas:**
- On large pieces of paper write *swimming pool, funfair, zoo, aquarium*.
 - Place the pieces of paper on the walls around the class.
 - Tell students that you are going to say objects and they have to point to the place that they associate with that object. For example, *fish*. Students should point to the word *aquarium*.
 - Continue with other vocabulary.
